When non-recyclable items are placed in with recyclables, the recycling container will be considered contaminated. . So, please take time to review "Acceptable" and "Unacceptable" items below. Thank you for your assistance.

Acceptable

(Do not place recyclables in plastic bags in cart)

Paper-Dry and Clean; Loose in Cart

Newspaper and inserts

Magazines, catalogues, junk mail, envelops, paperback books Corrugated cardboard boxes, Cereal type boxes (Tear Grey)

Containers-Empty and Clean; Place loose in carts

Aluminum cans

Glass bottles and jars (food and drink only) metal lids/caps loose

Plastics... Containers Labeled #1 thru #7 (soda/milk/juice/water/detergent/shampoo/food)
*******IMPORTANT!! RECYCLE PLASTIC BY SHAPE: Only bottles, jars, jugs, and tubs)

Metal Cans – Tin and Steel Cans (Food and beverage cans with lids)

Unacceptable NO PLASTIC BAGS IN RECYCLING CART

NO SHREDDED PAPER

- NO Food waste, garbage contaminated recyclables, no pizza boxes
- NO Styrofoam, cups, packing peanuts and packing plastic material, etc.
- NO Window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, florescent light bulbs or fixtures
- NO Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses, bowls, glass cookware/bakeware, Pyrex
- NO Tissues, paper towels, hard cover books, no SHREDDED PAPER
- NO Medical waste, syringes, propane tanks, insecticide and pesticide containers
- NO Tyvek envelopes, carbon paper, wax coated boxes and cartons
- NO Hangers, electrical cords, hoses, plastic or metal toys, etc.

Not Accepted for Recycling or Trash

NO ELECTRONICS
